3. Meeting Open To The Public (10 minutes):

John Smith gave a short presentation expressing concern for the increased amount of traffic that is coming though the village, and suggested repositioning the current speed restriction signs. He noted that currently the section of road between the Deane Gate and Steventon Arch is National Speed Limit, as is the section of road between Stoken Farm and North Waltham, and the section of road between Hatch Gate and Popham. PL said he would contact BDBC to explore what can be done. (PL)

If parishioners have any concerns about traffic from Stoken Farm then Matt Raymond is happy to talk with them.

Peter Harrison attended the meeting asking for clarification about the parish council's decision to object planning application 20/01927/FUL: Change of use from Agricultural livestock building to Commercial Storage (B8) with access via existing farm entrance. TC explained that the PC objected on the grounds of possible increase in traffic associated with this development, and the unsuitability of the lane as outlined in the consultee comment made by H.C.C.
